All players agree to conduct themselves in a courteous and respectful manner, both on and off the courts. By playing at the GPPC and RSES pickleball venues, you agree to the following Code of Conduct:

- I will not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct or encourage others to do so.
- I will not engage in any behavior that would endanger the health, safety or well-being of others.
- I will not engage in the use of profanity.
- I will treat the facility, equipment, staff and others with respect.
- I will exhibit fairness and honesty in my dealings with others.
- I will seek out staff if I have an issue with another player and/or situation.
- I will refrain from the use of any illegal substance on GPPC and RSES grounds.
- Children under the age of 16 may not be left unattended unless they are signed up for camp or other events.

The Director of Pickleball and Vail Recreation District management reserve the right to suspend, revoke or remove any person we feel is in violation of this Code of Conduct.
