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8. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

8.1. By motion duly made and seconded it was unanimously RESOLVED to approve the minutes of the October 27, 2011 Regular Board meeting as presented.

9. REVIEW AND APPROVE THE 2012 PROGRAM FEES

9.1. Mr. Eric weaver stated the golf daily fees have slightly been revised since the last meeting to slightly reduce the prior proposed increases. Upon a motion duly made and seconded it was unanimously RESOLVED to approve the 2012 Program fees.

10. CONTINUED PUBLIC HEARING AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSED 2012 BUDGET

- 10.1. Upon a motion duly made and seconded it was unanimously RESOLVED to reconvene the public hearing for the 2012 budget which had been continued from the October 27, 2012 meeting.
- 10.2. No public comment was given and the hearing was closed.
- 10.3. Mr. Weaver stated after reviewing the golf rates, minor changes were made to the golf budget for the anticipated additional revenues, which were offset by increased expenses including overseeding in the fall of 2012, an additional seeder machine and one more seasonal employee in golf maintenance, totaling \$21,500.
- 10.4. Director Sackbauer asked what the expected timeline would be to recoup the payoff of the raw water system at Ford park to ERWSD. Mr. Weaver responded that although he did not have the information with him, when he had reviewed the payoff it was within only a few years and that it was an easy decision to pay off the system and receive the lower water fees.
- 10.5. Upon a motion duly made and seconded it was unanimously RESOLVED approve the resolution to adopt the 2012 budget as presented, to approve the resolution to certify the mill levy at 2.760 mills for operations and 0.319 mills for a special mill levy approved at the 2004 election, and to approve the resolution to appropriate funds for spending in 2012, all of which are subject to minor adjustments which may result from the final certification of assessed values.
