



Golden Peak Pickleball Center Etiquette & Safety

- BE KIND!
- Respect the game, your partner, your opponents and the staff.
- When playing with new players, introduce yourself.
- Tap paddles at the end of a game.
- Call "ball" loudly when it enters another court.
- Make eye contact and return the ball to a person, not to a court.
- Do not cross over neighboring courts to get to your court. Please use the proper gate entrance.
- Do not enter the neighboring court to retrieve your ball. Wait until play has stopped and ask for your ball back.
- Avoid touching the net.
- Be punctual for your court reservation.
- Leave the court when your allotted time/reservation is over.
- Announce full score prior to each point when serving.
- Remove any trash from the court.
- Re-play any point where interference may have been an issue.
- If you are not certain of a call, then it goes your opponent's way.
- Be cognizant of where your paddle is at in line, and when it is your turn to play.
- Refrain from the use of electronic devices while playing a game.
- Try to play with other players at your ability level.
- When in a game with lower level players, adjust your play accordingly.
- Do not weigh in on calls of a game that you are not a part of, unless asked to do so.
- Notify management of any changes to your reservation.
